THE MEETING WAS PRESIDED OVER BY MAYOR KIM GASPARD.

CHIEF HOLLAND GAVE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT. HE STATED ALL APPARATUS ARE IN SERVICE. HE STATED THAT DAILY TRAINING CONTINUES FOR FULL TIME PERSONNEL. HE STATED THAT FIRE HOSE TESTING HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND LOGGED INTO THE SYSTEM. HE ALSO STATED THE STATE FORESTRY GRANT 2021 HAS BEEN SUBMITTED.
