


FIRE CHIEF JIMMY HOLLAND GAVE THE MONTHLY FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT. HE STATED THAT DAILY TRAINING FOR FULL-TIME PERSONNEL CONTINUES. HFD HELD ITS ANNUAL OPEN HOUSE ON OCTOBER 15TH. ALL APPARATUS ARE IN SERVICE. CHIEF HOLLAND ATTENDED THE LFCA FALL SYMPOSIUM.

POLICE CHIEF TODD GIBSON GAVE THE MONTHLY POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT. HE STATED THAT 76 CITATIONS WERE GIVEN. OFFICERS ATTENDED THEIR ANNUAL REQUIRED LEGAL UPDATE. PERMISSION WAS REQUESTED TO MOVE FORWARD IN FILLING THE OPEN POSITION OF POLICE OFFICER.
