

TOWN OF HAUGHTON COUNCIL MEETING

JUNE 14TH, 2022

THE COUNCIL MEETING WAS HELD AT THE HAUGHTON TOWN HALL ON TUESDAY, JUNE 14TH, 2022 AT 6:00 P.M.

COUNCIL MEMBERS PRESENT WERE DOUG ADAMS, CARLTON ANDERSON, BUCK MCGEE, COLBY ISOM, & PHILLIP SMITH.

THE MEETING WAS PRESIDED OVER BY MAYOR GASPARD

NEIL ERWIN, TOWN ATTORNEY, WAS PRESENT.

THE MEETING WAS OPENED WITH PRAYER BY COLBY ISOM AND THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE WAS LED BY PHILLIP SMITH.

THERE WERE SEVERAL CITIZENS PRESENT.

CHIEF HOLLAND GAVE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT A MONTHLY REPORT. HE STATED THE HAUGHTON FIRE DEPARTMENT ATTENDED HAUGHTON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL'S FIELD DAY. PERSONNEL ARE CURRENTLY CONDUCTING ANNUAL HOSE TESTING. DAILY TRAINING CONTINUES FOR FULL-TIME PERSONNEL. FIREFIGHTER ROSE WAS CERTIFIED AT THE FIRE INSTRUCTOR 1 LEVEL. FIREFIGHTER SMITH WILL BE ATTENDING FIRE OFFICER 1 COURSE IN JULY. PIAL GRADING HAS BEEN COMPLETED. THE DEPARTMENT WAS GRADED AS A CLASS 2 DEPARTMENT. THE DEPARTMENT IS NOW USING FIREWORKS SOFTWARE EXCLUSIVELY. PERSONNEL ARE CURRENTLY CONDUCTING ANNUAL PRE-PLAN REVIEWS.

CHIEF GIBSON WAS ABSENT, BUT SERGEANT CORKE GAVE THE MONTHLY REPORT. HE STATED THAT 174 TICKETS WERE WRITTEN. 23 NARCOTIC ARRESTS. A STOPPED CAR WITH STOLEN GUNS AND METHAMPHETAMINE. THE 2 SUBJECTS WERE ARRESTED AND ALSO HAD WARRANTS FROM SPD (SHREVEPORT) FOR ATTEMPTED 2ND DEGREE MURDER.

PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR JACKY HICKS WAS ABSENT. HIS REPORT STATED THAT 13 NEW CUSTOMERS RECEIVED METERS. 4 METER TOPS WERE REPLACED. 2 NON-WORKING METERS WERE REPLACED. REPAIRED WATER MAIN LEAK AT 615 HWY 3227. REPLACED BROKEN HYDRANT AT 131 REGAN LN. REPAIRED HYDRANT IN FOX CREEK. CONSTRUCTION AT THE SEWER PLANT CONTINUES. THE DEPARTMENT OPENED THE SPLASH PAD AND FIXED THE GATE. PUT SIGNS UP AT THE PARK. BUSH HOGGED AROUND TOWN.




